Students need to have one of the appropriate calculators below. How to use other calculators (e.g. Casio, Sharp) will not be taught in class!

Algebra 1, Geometry Algebra 2 must have either a Texas Instruments TI30XS Multiview or TI30X IIS Scientific Calculator. These calculators are shown below respectively. These will be needed in class and for out of class assignments. The calculators run from approximately \$11-14.



Precalculus/Trig and Calculus I students must have a TI83 Plus or TI84 graphing calculator. These calculators are expensive but have always been a requirement for my classes and are absolutely necessary to do the work required. Other brands will not be demonstrated in class or accepted. These calculators run from about \$55 on up to over \$100. The TI83 Plus is less expensive and is entirely acceptable. That is what I use myself. These calculators are pictured below.
